


the oldest parts of the church date back to 1190, but most of what you see is from the 13th and 14th centuries

Hedon Airfield, the perfect spot to view the rise of the supermoon in 2016










contrary to popular belief, the following three photos are not sunsets, but a camera with a sepia filter pointed up to a moody sky and then the contrast turned way up - I call them
